

## **ABILENE SPECTACULAR STALLION INCENTIVE *(Revised January 2025)***

Money raised through the stallion auction will be paid out at the following year's Abilene Spectacular. *(Example: Money collected in 2025 will be paid out in 2026.)*

### **Structure of Collected Money**

#### **FIRST:**

- **\$150,000 Total Open**
  - \$100,000 to the 4-Year-Old Open
  - \$50,000 to the 5/6-Year-Old Open

#### **THEN:**

- **\$100,000 Total Non-Pro** *(to be added as funds grow)*
  - \$50,000 to the 4-Year-Old Non-Pro
  - \$50,000 to the 5/6-Year-Old Non-Pro

#### **THEN:**

- **\$50,000 Total Amateur** *(to be added as funds grow)*
  - \$25,000 to the 4-Year-Old Amateur
  - \$25,000 to the 5/6-Year-Old Amateur

*If raised money exceeds \$300,000, additional funds will be split evenly between the 6 available classes.*

Guaranteed payout of 10 monies in each class. If there are not 10 eligible horses in the finals, cumulative scores after the second round will determine payouts.

**Projected Open Payout (4-Year-Old Open Division)**

1st Place (23%): \$23,000  
2nd Place (16%): \$16,000  
3rd Place (14%): \$14,000  
4th Place (11%): \$11,000  
5th Place (9%): \$9,000  
6th Place (8%): \$8,000  
7th Place (7%): \$7,000  
8th Place (5%): \$5,000  
9th Place (4%): \$4,000  
10th Place (3%): \$3,000

*(5/6-Year-Old Open Division payouts follow the same percentage structure but are reduced proportionally to the \$50,000 allocation.)*

1st Place (23%): \$11,500  
2nd Place (16%): \$8,000  
3rd Place (14%): \$7,000  
4th Place (11%): \$5,500  
5th Place (9%): \$4,500  
6th Place (8%): \$4,000  
7th Place (7%): \$3,500  
8th Place (5%): \$2,500  
9th Place (4%): \$2,000  
10th Place (3%): \$1,500

As the raise funds grow, the money will be paid out in the Non Pro.

**Projected Non Pro Payout (4 Year Old Non Pro and 5/6 Year Old Non Pro)**

1st Place (23%): \$11,500  
2nd Place (16%): \$8,000  
3rd Place (14%): \$7,000  
4th Place (11%): \$5,500  
5th Place (9%): \$4,500  
6th Place (8%): \$4,000  
7th Place (7%): \$3,500  
8th Place (5%): \$2,500  
9th Place (4%): \$2,000  
10th Place (3%): \$1,500

## **Projected Amateur Payout** *(4 Year Old Amateur and 5/6 Year Old Amateur)*

1st Place (23%): \$5,750  
2nd Place (16%): \$4,000  
3rd Place (14%): \$3,500  
4th Place (11%): \$2,750  
5th Place (9%): \$2,250  
6th Place (8%): \$2,000  
7th Place (7%): \$1,750  
8th Place (5%): \$1,250  
9th Place (4%): \$1,000  
10th Place (3%): \$750

## **Junior Stallions**

If a stallion donates a breeding during his first breeding year (e.g., 2025), offspring from that breeding will remain eligible for the program as 4-year-olds in 2030, even if the stallion does not donate again in subsequent years.

*Example: If "X" Stallion donates a breeding in 2025, and it results in a foal born in 2026, that foal will be eligible to compete as a 4-year-old in 2030, regardless of the stallion's participation in later years.*

**Eligibility:** All foals sired by donated stallions are now eligible for this added purse, regardless of whether they are the result of the purchased breeding.

## **Alternative Enrollment Option**

If "X" Stallion does not donate a breeding to the auction, but still wants to have foals to be eligible - The stallion owner can pay the amount of their advertised stud fee into the incentive fund and make their foals eligible.

If any donated breeding does not sell at auction, the owner has the option to purchase their stallion's breeding back themselves at \$600.00 in order to maintain the eligibility of their stallion's foals.
